# 106<sup>th</sup> REPORT OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019

\*\*\*\*\*\*

The Managing Committee has great pleasure in presenting its Report for the year ended 31st March 2019.

During the year under review, the **Gross Income** of the Sabha was ₹1,67,92,446 as compared to ₹1,61,25,603 in the previous year. The **expenditure** was ₹1,34,92,907 as against ₹1,33,80,519 last year after providing ₹5,19,218 for depreciation. ₹6,94,385 being provision for Gratuity Payment has been made. The year thus ended with a surplus of ₹32,99,539 which has been transferred to the General Fund.

**The Investments** as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019 of the Sabha totalled ₹9,78,00,000 as against ₹9,37,50,000 on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018. Schedule 'E' of the Accounts contains the details of investments. As usual, the investments have been made giving due attention to safety of principal and returns thereon.

Free Scholarships were disbursed to the extent of ₹30,09,000 to 537 students studying in various courses as detailed in Appendix I.

Free Scholarship Endowments: During the year, the Sabha received 203 Free Scholarship Endowments of ₹2,500 each from Members totalling ₹5,07,500 which included 52 endowments out of ₹1,33,510 received from Members abroad through Foreign Contributions, as against ₹8,20,000 during the previous year. The total number of Free Scholarship Endowments as on 31-03-2019 was 6037. The particulars of endowments received during the year under Report are given in Supplement No.9 of this Report.

The Endowments from Members, together with the donations and endowments from well-wishers, have enabled the Scholarship Endowment Corpus Fund to reach ₹5,42,10,944 as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019. The Committee takes the opportunity to thank all the generous donors and appeals for their continued support.

Foreign Contributions Regulation Act (FCRA): During the year under report, the Sabha received ₹1,33,510 through FCRA towards Free Scholarship Endowment Corpus.

During the year under report ₹5,41,961 was spent on **Poor Relief** directly benefitting 77 persons as against ₹7,50,011 to 102 persons during 2017-18. The details are shown in Appendix II of this Report.

An Eye Camp was organized in association with Sri Ramachandra Medical College Hospital and Research Centre on Saturday, 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2018 between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. to identify the power of the eye (individual) and prescribe necessary glass. No active intervention was conducted during the camp. Those who required glasses were given spectacles free of charge by the Sabha. The programme was held for the benefit of

the underprivileged members of our community. A total of 64 persons attended the camp. Breakfast and lunch were provided to the beneficiaries and volunteers. A total of ₹39,962 was spent on this Eye Camp.

Sixth Cardiac Review Camp, along with Diabetic Screening, in association with Obstetric Dept. of Sri Ramachandra Medical College and Hospital was conducted for the underprivileged section of our community on 16th & 17th March 2019. A total of 97 persons attended the camp and were screened. On 16th March, Height, Weight and Blood Pressure were recorded for the beneficiaries followed by Complete Blood Count, Fasting Blood Sugar, Blood Urea, Serum Creatinine and Lipid Profile investigations. Two hours after breakfast blood was taken for post prandial blood sugar investigation. ECG, Ultrasound Scan of the abdomen and Echo were also performed. On 17th March all the beneficiaries were examined with the results and advised suitable treatment. Cardiologists and Diabetologists of Sri Ramachandra Hospitals examined the patients. They were given medicines free of cost for two weeks and B-Complex was supplied for one month. Nutritional specialists talked to the patients on an individual basis and advised diet. All the volunteers and beneficiaries were provided with breakfast and lunch on both days. A total of ₹1,29,249 was spent on this medical camp. We thank all volunteers for their active involvement in supporting the medical team and helping the beneficiaries right from the beginning till the end of these two camps.

Under the New Medical Schemes that was launched with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2014 for the benefit of the economically weaker sections of our community, two persons availed a total of ₹50,000 as assistance for medical expenses. This was based on the recommendations made by the Medical Committee after duly scrutinizing their Medical Report, Doctor's Certificate, Income Certificate and the Medical Bills.

**Income Tax status**: Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals) Order dated 3/8/2018 was received on 18/9/2018 for A.Y. 2010-11, A.Y. 2012-13, A.Y. 2013-14 and A.Y. 2014-15 against our appeals accepting Income Tax Assessing Officer's Order on denying of exemption u/s 11 and invoking the amendments to Section 2(15) taking all receipts as commercial and not towards object of general public utility.

However for the A.Y. 2011-12, A.Y. 2015-16 and A.Y. 2016-17 based on our self assessment, a refund for these years were obtained from the IT. Dept.:

The Department, however, can re-open the assessments for scrutiny for the above three years.

Appeal before the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal: In view of the Order dated 3/8/2018 received from the Commissioner of Appeals, the Managing Committee decided that the Sabha need to appeal to the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal against the Appeal Order as the Sabha stands a fair chance in getting relief at the Tribunal level. Besides the High Court Judgment of 24/3/2000 and in that we adhere the same principle even today and that in our earlier Income Tax cases we were successful at the Tribunal and High Court level, the following case laws are also in favour of the Sabha. 1. AVM Charities, 2. Thyaga Brahma Gana Sabha, 3. Tamil Nadu Cricket Association and 4.Tamil Nadu Tennis Association.

It was also decided by the Managing Committee that Mr. S. Sridhar, B.Com., B.L., a leading Advocate in Income Tax cases to represent the Sabha before the Appellate Tribunal after studying his bio-data. The Hon. Treasurer while briefing the status on Income Tax at the last General Body on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2018, had explained all these matters.

Accordingly, the Appeal before the ITAT was filed on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2018. First hearing was held on 24<sup>th</sup> January 2019 and the second on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019. The third hearing was posted for 29<sup>th</sup> July 2019.

Interest waiver petitions before the Chief Commissioner of Income Tax (Exemptions) New Delhi for A.Y. 2010-11, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15: The waiver petitions before the Chief Commissioner of Income Tax (Exemptions) have been heard for three assessment years where Orders are pending. For A.Y. 2012-13 the hearing and discussions were held on 4th July 2019. The interest demand u/s 234B & 234C are as follows:

We had mentioned in our last year's (105<sup>th</sup>) Report that in order to keep our interest waiver petitions alive and to avoid piling up of interest component, the Sabha paid during the year 2017-18, net tax demand after deducting advance tax paid and excluding interest - ₹20,98,568 for Assessment Year 2010-11, ₹27,13,856 for Assessment Year 2012-13, ₹24,93,679 for Assessment Year 2013-14 and ₹26,57,416 for Assessment Year 2014-15 – a total of ₹99,63,519. Including advance tax of ₹17,19,143 paid earlier, the total tax paid amounted to ₹1,16,82,662.

Accumulation of Funds: To avail the benefit of exemption under section 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 the Sabha has accumulated the funds of ₹7,03,283 for the Assessment Year 2014-15. ₹1,32,793 for the Assessment Year 2015-16, ₹30,48,945 for the Assessment Year 2016-17, ₹14,28,450 for the Assessment Year 2017-18, ₹7,66,826 for Assessment Year 2018-19 and invested the funds in Fixed Deposits as specified under section 11(5) of

the Income Tax Act, 1961. However, during the year 2016-17 accumulation for the Assessment Year 2014-15 had been fully utilized by us to the extent of ₹7,03,283, during the year 2017-18 accumulation of ₹1,32,793 for the Assessment Year 2015-16 and during the year 2018-19 accumulation for the A.Y. 2016-17 to the extent of ₹1,73,958 had been utilized and the balance is carried forward to spend in the next years.

**Wealth Tax**: Follow up action is being taken for getting the refund of Wealth Tax at ₹1,96,820 paid for the assessment year 1986-87, under protest from the department.

Ganesh Chaturthi was performed for five days from 13<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> September 2018 with the usual enthusiastic participation of the community members. The Committee conveys its thanks for the active support of volunteers and members for making this a successful event year after year. Ganesh Chaturthi Shashwat Seva Endowments Corpus Fund stood at ₹21,28,493 as on 31-03-2019. We request members to continue to contribute generously in cash and in kind.

**Repairs, Renewals & Maintenance**: The expenditure incurred was ₹11,41,100 which included painting, general maintenance of utensils, electrical, furniture and fittings, water supply, sanitation etc. as against ₹26,11,717 during 2017-18. A brief note on Repairs, Renewals & Maintenance is given in Appendix IV

**Members References:** During the year under review we had received a reference from one of our members on the powers of your Managing Committee on filing the Appeal Petition in our Income Tax cases, on recommendation of the statutory Auditor to the AGM among other issues. In consultation with our Advocate and keeping our Bye-Laws in mind a reply was given.

Another member addressed an issue on the Sabha conducting a Career Guidance Programme for its young members. After detailed discussion at the Managing Committee level, while the concept in principle was accepted as laudable, as the current data base on membership could not enable specific identification of beneficiaries, it was decided to defer this project for the present.

Some members had also requested for reviewing our Accounts Statements, Our Annual Reports documents, Membership Data and Minutes of our Annual General Meetings and Managing Committee Meetings. These were shown to them as provided for in our Bye-Laws.

**Demitting of office by Secretary -** Mr. C.J. Nayak who has been the Hon Secretary of the Sabha since 1998 demitted office on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 due to personal reasons. The committee wishes to place on record deep appreciation of his services to the Sabha during his tenure. The committee has authorized Mr. Vasant M. Shanbhag, Joint Secretary, to discharge the functions of Secretary effective from 21<sup>st</sup> April 2019.

**Membership**: The Sabha had 2718 Life Members and 9 Ordinary Members on its rolls as on 31st March 2019.

The Managing Committee has received in abundant measure the support, co-operation and patronage from all members and well-wishers and wishes to thank them all. The Sabha staff and workers too have carried out their duties with dedication. The Managing Committee hopes that such co-operation will continue in future also.

#### **Schedule G - Notes on Accounts:**

#### 1. Significant Accounting Policies:

- (a) Financial Accounts are prepared under historical cost convention except inland insurance claim which are accounted on receipt basis. Gratuity is accounted on accrual basis.
- (b) Fixed Assets are capitalised at acquisition cost. Depreciation is charged on written down value in accordance with the rates of depreciation as provided in the Income Tax Rules
- (c) The Gold and Silver Ornaments received as donations have been taken into account at the market value prevailing on the date of receipt of such donations.
- 2. Subscription from Ordinary Members is recognised on admission for such membership or as and when such member renews the membership subscription. Subject to as aforesaid, Revenues and Expenditures are recognised on accrual basis.
- 3. The Revision Orders consequent to the Orders of the High Court of Madras for the Wealth Tax Assessment Years 1986-87, 1987-88, 1989-90 and 1990-91 are pending. A sum of ₹ 1,96,820 is receivable being tax paid towards Wealth Tax the Revision Orders of and when passed. This will be admitted as and when realised.
- 4. The refund received from income tax department amounting to ₹ 4,57,860 and ₹ 5,18,860 for AY 2015-16 and AY 2016-17 has been netted of with the tax paid. The breakup of refund received is as under:

#### 5. Contingent Liability (without prejudice to our claim for exemption):

- (a) The Income Tax Assessment for the year ended 31-03-2012 (I.T. Assessment Year 2012 13) has been completed. The Assessing Officer has completed the Income Tax Assessment by assessing Sabha's income at ₹ 92,76,040 on a demand of ₹ 36,63,721. The Sabha's appeal before the Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals) -17, Chennai, has been decided against. Income Tax provision for this Assessment Year has been made to the extent of ₹ 3,53,926 after adjusting refund due of ₹ 15,180 for that Assessment Year. An appeal has been filed before ITAT which is pending.
- (b) The Income Tax Assessment was reopened u/s147 for the Assessment Year 2010-11 (Financial Year 2009-10) by invoking the amended proviso of section 2(15) and was completed by determining income at ₹83,09,981 on a tax demand of ₹42,46,515. The Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals) -17, Chennai had decided against the Sabha, after which the Sabha has preferred an appeal before ITAT, which is pending. The total demand of ₹42,46,515 is not provided for in the books pending disposal of appeal.

- (c) The Income Tax Assessment for I.T. Assessment Year 2013-14 and 2014-15 (Financial Year 2012-13 and 2013-14) have been completed by determining income of ₹1,00,60,973 and ₹1,21,07,642 and on a Tax demand of ₹39,87,050 and ₹42,61,120. The Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals) -17, Chennai had decided against the Sabha, after which the Sabha has preferred an appeal before ITAT, which is pending. The net tax demand of ₹39,87,050 and ₹42,61,120 is not provided for in the books pending disposal of appeal.
- (d) Tax demand including interest has been fully paid pending disposal of appeal without prejudice to our claim for exemption based on Sabha's favourable decision, earlier in Madras High Court.
- (e) Sabha has filed interest waiver petition before Chief Commissioner of Income Tax (Exemptions) for the above Assessment Years for interest levied under section 234(b) and 234(c) which is pending.
- 6. To avail benefit of exemption under section 11 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 the Sabha has accumulated funds of ₹ 30,48,945 for the Assessment Year 2016-17, ₹ 14,28,450 for the Assessment Year 2017-18, ₹ 7,66,826 for the Assessment year 2018-19. The excess expenditure of ₹ 1,73,958 during the AY 2019-20, has been utilized from the accumulation of AY 2016-17 and the balance of ₹ 28,74,987 will be carried forward.
- 7. Figures have been rounded off to nearest Rupee. Previous year's figures have been regrouped wherever necessary.

Mr. A. Arjuna Pai, President, took the Chair and called the meeting to order.

The meeting commenced with Invocation Prayer rendered by Mrs. Vijayalakshmi R. Pai and Mrs. Rama Shenoi.

The President extended, on behalf of the Managing Committee, a warm welcome and greetings to all members to this 105<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of our Sabha and that their presence was indeed a reflection of their keen interest in the Sabha. He thanked them all for their patronage.

Before taking up the Agenda, President referred to the passing away of some of our members since the last AGM. Among those who are no longer with us are: Uday Naimpally, N.V. Bhat, Mrs. U. Premalatha Shenoy, R.R. Pai, U. Ramanan Kamath, B.R. Rajkumar Bhat, Mrs. Vasantha Venugopal Rao, V. Babu Prabhu, R. Radhakrishna Pai, Mrs. Prema R. Bhatt, Kochi; N. Krishnan Mallya, E.A. Sadananda Shenoy, Mrs. S. Lakshmi Prabhu, Mrs. K.J. Nayak, N.K. Kamath, V. Prabhakaran Shenoy, Mrs. Jayalakshmi R. Shenoy, S. Purushothama Rao, V.G. Purushothama Kamath, Mrs. R. Shantha Bhat and Brig. M.H. Pai.

Members present observed a minute's silence as a mark of respect to the departed souls.

Agenda Item 1 – To adopt the Minutes of the 104<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2017: The President invited Members' attention to the Minutes of the last AGM and invited for adoption of the Minutes. The Minutes were adopted duly proposed by Mr. Krishnakumar Shenoy and G.V. Prashanthkumar Baliga.

Agenda Item 2 - To receive and adopt the 105th Annual Report of the Managing Committee, the audited Balance Sheet as at 31-03-2018 and the Income & Expenditure Account for the year ended 31-03-2018: The President invited Members' attention to the significant increase in Free Scholarship Endowment Corpus Fund and Ganesh Chaturthi Shashwat Seva Endowment Fund as explained in the Annual Report, He mentioned in detail on the Free Scholarship disbursements, Poor Relief Assistance, Medical Assistance, assistance given under the Medical Expenses Reimbursement Scheme. Two Medical Camps in association with Sri Ramachandra Medical College Hospital were held for the benefit of the economically weaker section of the community, viz. Women's Wellness Screening Camp on 12th & 13th August 2017 in which 47 ladies attended. A Mammogram was also arranged at Sri Ramachandra Medical College Hospital on 9th, 10th & 11th August. A van was arranged to take the patients to the hospital for examination. They were picked and dropped at the Sabha and were provided breakfast and lunch. The fifth Cardiac Review Camp along with Diabetic Screening Camp on 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> March 2018 in which 105 persons attended. All the beneficiaries and volunteers of these three camps were provided with breakfast and lunch. He thanked all volunteers for their active involvement in supporting the medical team and helping the beneficiaries right from 6.30 a.m. till the end.

Wealth Tax: Follow up action is continued for getting the refund of Wealth Tax of ₹1,96,820 paid under protest for the Assessment Year 1986-87 from the Department

The expenditure incurred under Repairs, Renewals & Maintenance was ₹26.12 lakhs which included renovation of Secretary's Office which was damaged during floods in 2015, in addition to painting, general maintenance of utensils, electrical, furniture and fittings, water supply, sanitation etc. as against ₹29.55 lakhs last year.

During the year our Investments stood at ₹9.37 crores as against ₹9.70 crores last year.

President mentioned on the 5-day Ganesh Chaturthi celebrations which went off successfully with the enthusiastic participation of the community members and active support of volunteers and Mahila Vibhag.

Mahila Vibhag had been conducting regularly their monthly meeting as usual on various subjects of interest.

President informed that under the directions and guidance of H.H. Srimad Samyamindra Tirtha Swamiji, Mathadhipati of Sri Kashi Math Samsthan to co-ordinate flood relief work with the Sudhindra Tirtha Swamiji Charitable Trust based in Ambalamedu, Kochin, to our affected samaj bandhavas in Kerala, the Sabha had contributed ₹50,000 towards this noble cause.

The President then requested Hon. Treasurer, Mr. K.P. Lakshmana Rao, to give an update of the Sabha's Income Tax status.

The Hon. Treasurer said he would explain our financial position from two broad approaches. One from our overall financial position keeping in view of our Income Tax case, and second, the Order of Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals) which was just received last week and discussed at the Managing Committee level.

#### 1. On overall financial position

- (a) In view of the decision pending before the Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals) and In order to keep our interest waiver petitions alive and to avoid piling up of interest component, the Sabha paid during the year net tax demand after deducting advance tax paid and excluding interest − ₹20,98,568 for A.Y. 2010-11, ₹27,13,856 for A.Y. 2012-13, ₹24,93,679 for A.Y. 2013-14 and ₹26,57,416 for A.Y. 2014-15 a total of ₹99,63,519. Including advance tax of ₹17,19,143 paid earlier, the total tax paid amounted to ₹1,16,82,662.
- (b) You will notice that on one side the Sabha had to pay tax on demand and on the other the Sabha received refund from IT dept. based on our self-assessment for three years. We have received refund from I.T. Dept ₹0.36 lakhs for A.Y. 2011-12, ₹4.57 lakhs for A.Y. 2015-16 and ₹5.18 lakhs for A.Y. 2016-17. However, the Department can re-open the assessment for scrutiny for the above three years.
- (c) Another aspect on the account is on "Accumulated Fund" which find mention as Note 5 of Schedule 'F' of the accounts. To avail benefit of exemption under Rule 11 by the IT Act, these funds stand invested through our FD and will in future be used for designated provisions like Education to the deserving student, Relief to Poor including Medical Aid and expenditure by way of purchase of Fixed Assets or renovation of existing building.

#### 2. Order of Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals)

On Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals) Order dated 3/8/2018 received at the Sabha on 18/9/2018 for A.Y. 2010-11, A.Y. 2012-13, A.Y. 2013-14 and A.Y. 2014-15 it was explained that this order comes after 3 ½ years after our first appeal and resulted in the above mentioned financial position. The Order accept Income Tax Assessing Officer's Order on denying of exemption u/s 11 and invoking the amendments to Sec.2(15) taking all the receipts as commercial and not towards object of general public utility.

He then briefly traced the history of this appeal case as reported first in the Annual Report 103 (Year ending 31/3/2016), then 104 (Year ending 31/3/2017) and 105 (Year Ending 31/3/2018). The Origins of this case, the ITO Assessment Orders received, our appeals made with details of case studies and justification, and backing of the historical High Court Judgment dated 24/3/2000 in our favour, our Tax History, our earlier Interaction with IT Dept., and the current stand over the IT Dept. were all explained and duly recorded in 104<sup>th</sup> Report. Report 105 in detail brings out our appeal petition, delay issue and interest waiver petition, clearly listing out 2 important implications which are valid even today. Our overall financial position remains robust with a healthy investment portfolio of ₹9.37 Crores today, after payment of the said tax and should enable us to meet such demands in future.

He then explained that in the recent Order of Commissioner of Appeals on the two issues of receipt from Kalyana Mandapam activities, and concerning education and corpus donations were not in our favour while that on depreciation of Assessment Years under consideration was in our favour. After detailed discussion in the Managing Committee it was decided to file the Appeal before the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal against the Appeal Order as the Sabha stands a fair chance in getting relief at the Tribunal level. Besides the High Court Judgment of 24/3/2000 and in that we adhere the same principle even today, and that in our earlier Income Tax cases we were successful at the Tribunal and High Court level the following case laws are also in favour of the Sabha: 1. AVM Charities, 2. Thyaga Brahma Gana Sabha, 3. Tamil Nadu Cricket Association and 4. Tamil Nadu Tennis Association.

It was also decided at the Managing Committee meeting that Mr. S. Sridhar, B.Com., B.L., a leading Advocate in Income Tax cases to represent the Sabha before the Appellate Tribunal after studying his bio-data.

The President thanked Mr. Lakshmana Rao for giving the Income Tax update so distinctly.

The President then requested for observation, if any, on the Annual Report and Accounts. Mr. SK. Rahul Vivek Kamath raised the issue on whether we are a private or a public trust and it was indicated that the High Court Judgment of 24/3/2000 indicated that we adhere to the section 11 exemption. Mr. Lakshmana Rao said that he looked forward to inputs from our members and he could show them the relevant records. Mr. Krishnakumar thanked Mr. Lakshmana Rao for giving detailed updates on Income Tax though he mentioned he is only briefing. He recollected that the Treasurer had given all details at the AGM held on 25/09/2016 right from the earlier action taken with the IT Dept since 1967/68 and also highlighted the High Court Judgment in 2000 in Sabha's

favour and updated at the AGM held on 24/9/2017. He thanked him for explaining the same again in brief with current updates and he was sure of getting relief at the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal level. Mr. SK. Rahul Vivek Kamath observed that ₹26.12 lakhs was spent on Repairs & Maintenance on renovation of Secretary's office and rest room which was damaged during floods in 2015. He also pointed out that ₹29.55 lakhs was spent on renovation of Gents and Ladies toilet blocks etc. He wanted breakup of the expenditure to which Hon. Treasurer informed that details statement of expenditure will be available at the office. He wanted the brief break up be incorporated in Annual Report to which Mr. Lakshmana Rao agreed. The 105th Annual Report, the audited Balance Sheet as at 31/03/2018 and the Income & Expenditure Account for the year ended on 31/03/2018 were unanimously adopted duly proposed by Mr. K.J. Gnanamurthy and seconded by Mr. H. Mohandas Pai.

Agenda Item No.3 – Appointment of Auditors to hold office till the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting and to fix their remuneration: President stated that keeping the competency of our current Auditor in handling Taxation, Audit and Accounts matters related to the SGS Sabha, the Managing Committee, after deliberation, at its meeting held on 23/9/2017 passed the following Resolution:

"The Managing Committee RESOLVED to recommend to the AGM, the re-appointment of M/s. P.B. Vijayaraghavan & Co., Chartered Accountants, as our Statutory Auditors for the Financial Year 2018-19 at an Audit Fee of ₹45,000 plus all statutory dues."

The President moved the Resolution for re-appointment of the Audit Firm M/s. P.B. Vijayaraghavan & Co. as our Statutory Auditors for the financial year 2017-18 and till the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting on a remuneration of ₹45,000 as statutory Audit Fee plus applicable taxes and fees for additional services.

The President clarified to a query that Auditors are not appointed on the basis of caste or religion and are considered on the basis of their qualification, experience and professional standing. Mr. Rahul Vivek Kamath asked that the auditor is to be appointed only by the AGM. The President said that, that is the reason why the Resolution is moved in the AGM. Then the member said that the Managing Committee does not have any power to recommend the Auditor. The President stated that this is the universal procedure followed for appointment of auditors as the general management powers are vested with the Managing Committee. However, a legal opinion will be obtained in this matter. The member wanted to defer and postpone the appointment of auditors to some other date. Mr. Krishnakumar objected to this suggestion and pointed out that though we have qualified people in our society it should be ensured that they are competent enough to handle the accounts and tax matters of this type with their experience.

Mr. Suresh Mallya suggested that a Lawyer from GSB community be elected to the Managing Committee. His suggestion was noted.

Mr. Suresh A. Pai requested the President to put the resolution to vote.

At that time Dr. H.R. Shanbhogue, Vice-President, said that the Sabha is the part of a larger society and cannot take a narrow view on the basis of caste, creed and religion.

He also stressed that the tax issues (in relation to the Income Tax Dept.) of the Sabha are at a critical stage now and so the person who is handling it now will be the best person to continue until the problems are addressed, completed and taken to its logical conclusion. On the Auditor, the said member can take up the issue over the next one year and the next Executive Committee and the General Body can take a stand on it on merit after necessary discussion. He also said that none in the Managing Committee has any desire to usurp the rights of any member of the Sabha.

The President then moved the Resolution once again and asked for a proposer and seconder.

Duly proposed by Mr. Suresh A. Pai and seconded by Mr. V. Mohandass the Resolution was passed unanimously.

Item 4. To consider any further matters that may be notified to the Secretary before 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2018: The President informed that no notification had come from members to consider at the AGM.

The President then invited Dr. H.R. Shanbhogue to give Vote of Thanks.

In his vote of thanks Dr. H.R. Shanbhogue said: "Ladies & Gentlemen, we thank Mrs. Vijayalakshmi R. Pai and Mrs. Rama Shenoi for rendering invocation song this evening. We are grateful to all those members, especially senior citizens and women members, who graced this meeting and participated in our deliberations. We thank our President, Mr. A. Arjuna Pai, for conducting our AGM efficiently. For the planning and execution of all the activities of the Sabha, including Ganesh Chaturthi function, our thanks to the members of Managing Committee, ably guided by Our Joint Secretary Mr. Vasant M. Shanbhag in the absence of our Secretary Mr. C.J. Nayak. Our Ganesh Chaturthi celebrations in all its grace was possible, thanks largely to the tireless efforts of our dedicated volunteers and benevolent donors. Our thanks are also due to the volunteers of Mahila Vibhag who worked tirelessly for making all our functions a great success. We thank our Hon. Treasurer, Mr. K.P. Lakshmana Rao, for his excellent and meticulous handling of all financial matters. We thank all the members of the Sabha for their whole hearted co-operation and support throughout the year. Our thanks to M/s. P.B. Vijayaraghavan & Co. for completing the audit on time and for all the guidance in Income Tax and financial matters. Every function and activity in this Sabha was largely possible due to the dedicated and willing co-operation of our Office Staff. Our thanks go to them with full earnest."

The President then declared the meeting closed.
